

**DECISIONS TAKEN REGARDING HAZARDOUS WASTE RECYCLERS DURING THE
32ND REGISTRATION COMMITTEE MEETING HELD AT CPCB**

An interaction meet was organized with representatives from industries engaged in Hazardous waste (non-ferrous metals and lead) recycling., the problems faced by the industry were discussed in detail with Registration Committee Members. The following in this regard were taken:

- a) The application for Registration can also be processed on the basis of Consent to Establish issued by the SPCB/PCC instead of Consent to Operate as per Rule 19 (2) (a) of HW (M&H) Rule 2003. After installation of plant and machineries including all processing facilities of HW, the unit shall inform CPCB in writing. This would reduce the time for which the industries have to remain non-operational after completing installation of facilities, awaiting Registration from CPCB
- b) The HW recycling industries have to provide to CPCB complete details of HW procured, processed and finished goods products sold by 31st January every year. This is required to prevent trading of HW for which various complaints are being received by CPCB
- c) The industry representatives can meet Incharge HWMD/concerned officials on last Friday of every month between 4 P.M to 5 P.M to discuss various issues related to registration
- d) The status of application for registration pending with CPCB shall be displayed on CPCB's website
