Minutes of the 41st meeting of the Registration Committee
Held at CPCB on 14th January, 2009

- Sh. R.K. Garg, Chairman of Committee welcomed the participants and discussed about the decisions taken during the 40th meeting of Registration Committee held on 23rd November 2009. Shri B.P. Shukla, Additional Director & Incharge Hazardous Waste Division briefed the committee members on the actions taken on the decisions of 40th meeting. List of participants enclosed as Annexure 3.
- The committee was informed that all recyclers and refiners of used/waste oil have been asked to submit details of procurement/processing and disposal of Hazardous waste during the last three years/ registration period.
- Member Secretary, Central Board highlighted the issues related to registration including maintaining transparency in the process. In the meeting the following issues were discussed & decisions taken:
 - ❖ To bring transparency into the process of registration, on line procedure for receipt of application for registration is required to be put in place.
 - ❖ The shortcomings identified in the inspection report to be placed on the web site of CPCB and informed to the applicant online also.
 - ❖ In case the applicant does not furnish the required information within 30 days of being informed on line/by post so, a reminder be issued in case of failure of the applicant to provide the required information the application may be rejected.
 - ❖ SPCBs be asked to provide compliance report to CPCB within 30 days of receipt of letter from CPCB otherwise it will be presumed that the industry is complying and case dealt accordingly.
 - ❖ Granting registration to industries for recycling of hazardous waste falling within the critically polluted areas identified by CPCB be taken in conformity with the notification issued by MoEF.
 - ❖ If the committee feels that cases are too many, then the meeting of the registration committee can be held every month.
 - ❖ Applicants for Used Oil/Waste Oil/Lead recyclers or any other industry wherever required may be asked to give the presentation.
 - ❖ Next Regional Workshop of SPCBs/CPCB officials on the registration issue should be held early preferably in North Zone.
- The committee stressed on the need for conducting surprise check of a few registered recyclers on random basis so as to ensure that units operate and maintain the ESM facility consistently.

- The committee was of the opinion that all the lead acid battery plate recyclers should have alkaline scrubber along with the system for treatment of effluent.
- All the lead acid battery recyclers should ensure treatment of the acid generated from batteries as well as the washing of the plastic casings.
- The committee was informed that many applications are pending for want of information for last many months. It was decided that the applicants be asked to submit the required information within 20 days failing which the application be rejected and applicant will be informed.
- The Committee decided that the next registration committee meeting will be held in the end of February 2010.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the chair.
