CIRCULAR

Sub: Providing medical treatment to retired employees of CPCB and their dependant family members in the empanelled hospitals/diagnostic centres of CPCB on payment basis as per CGHS rates/CSMA Rules without any financial burden on CPCB - reg.

All CPCB retired officials/employees are hereby informed that the Central Board in its 177th Board Meeting vide Agenda Item No. 3.5 has accorded approval for providing medical treatment to all retired officials/employees of CPCB and their dependant family members in the empanelled hospitals/diagnostic centres of CPCB on payment basis as per CGHS rates/CSMA Rules without any financial burden on CPCB. The CPCB will provide medical cards to all retired officials/employees of CPCB for taking medical treatment from the empanelled hospitals/diagnostic centres. The entire expenditure for such treatment has to be borne by the retired employee or their dependent family members and CPCB will not bear any expenditure incurred towards treatment. The scheme is to help retired CPCB employee to get the medical facilities as per CGHS Rates/CSMA Rules.

In view of the above, all retired CPCB officials/employees who are interested to take the benefit of medical treatment from empanelled hospitals/diagnostic centres of CPCB on payment basis as per CGHS rates/CSMA Rules, may apply for issuing medical card on a prescribed format which may be downloaded from the CPCB website : www.cpcb.nic.in/csma.php within 30 days from the issue of this circular.
