A COMBINED EFFLUENT TREATMENT PLANT AT DELHI

A combined effluent treatment plant consisting of Physicochemical treatment units will soon be constructed in Wazirpur Industrial Area, Delhi. The Plant will receive 10,000 cubic metres per day of industrial wastewater from a number of electroplating, rolling and pickling and textile units. The present estimated cost is Rs. 1.5 crores.
