Sir,

It is to inform you that M/s Shital Fibers Limited, A-17, Focal Point Extension, Jalandhar, Punjab was inspected by a team of CPCB officials on 24.06.2021 to verify the compliance status of the industries under the special drive in catchment of River Sutlej within the jurisdiction of Punjab. It was observed that the concentration of Oil & Grease (22.8 mg/l. against 10 mg/l) was exceeding effluent discharge norms. Based on the observations made by the inspection team, the following recommendations are required to be complied by the unit:

1. The unit should ensure proper operation & maintenance of the ETP so as to achieve the prescribed norms and submit analysis report of treated effluent from E(P) A approved laboratory to CPCB within 30 days from the date of receipt of this direction.
2. The unit should obtain permission from Central Ground Water Authority (CGWA) for extraction of the ground water.
3. The unit should install electromagnetic flow meters for both the bore wells and maintain the record related to amount of ground water extracted.

In this context, it is requested to ensure compliance of the aforesaid recommendations of the inspection team and terms & conditions of the consent to operate granted by Punjab PCB and submit ATR to CPCB at the earliest.

This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority. .
