Minutes of Twenty ninth meeting of Task Force on Graded Response Action Plan held on October 26, 2018 at CPCB, Delhi

Twenty ninth meeting of Task Force on Graded Response Action Plan (GRAP) was convened on October 26, 2018 at Central Pollution Control Board, Delhi, to further discuss issues for maintaining air quality in Delhi and NCR during the upcoming winters 2018-19. Meeting was chaired by Member Secretary, CPCB. The list of participants is annexed (Annexure - I).

MS welcomed the participants and appraised the members on levels of air pollution in Delhi NCR showing an upward trend. Air quality in Delhi NCR has already reached 'Very Poor' AQI levels due to less dispersion of pollutants on account of unfavorable meteorological conditions. Shri Siddharth Singh, IMD informed on similar metrological condition would continue in next few days, resulting in poor dispersion of pollutants. It was also informed that at beginning of November the situation may get further detiorated on account of localized emissions during festival and regional contribution due to stubble burning.

In view of this and considering previous years' experience, Task Force recommends following additional measures as proactive steps to deal with the situation for consideration of EPCA:

- All construction activities involving excavation, civil construction (excluding internal finishing/work where no construction material is used), stone crushers, hot mix plants, etc. generating dust pollution to remain closed in Delhi & other NCR during November 01 10, 2018
- Coal and Biomass based Industries (excluding thermal and Waste to Energy Plants) to remain closed in Delhi NCR from November 04 10, 2018.
- Transport department/Traffic police to intensify checking of polluting vehicles and control traffic congestion in Delhi NCR during November 01 10, 2018
- General public is advised to minimize exposure, travel & communicating with private vehicles.
- Efforts may be made for uninterrupted power supply in NCR towns to avoid requirement of operating DG sets and inconvenience to public.
