

**Minutes of Thirty First Meeting of Task Force on Graded Response Action Plan
held on November 02, 2018**

Thirty first meeting of Task Force on Graded Response Action Plan (GRAP) was convened on November 02, 2018 at Central Pollution Control Board, Delhi, to review ambient air quality status in Delhi and NCR. Meeting was chaired by Member Secretary, CPCB. The list of participants is annexed (Annexure - I).

Shri V.K. Soni, IMD informed that favourable meteorological conditions are expected tomorrow and day after tomorrow. However, with higher upper winds from North West directions and incidences of crop stubble burning air quality might deteriorate further.

Task Force do not made any additional recommendations, and advised to intensify all efforts to be implemented by concerned agencies, as advised earlier.

MS, CPCB asked the IT division to provide a daily update on the no. of complaints received, complaints forwarded to the concerned agencies and no. of complaints resolved during the 'Clean Air for Delhi' campaign, 2018.

The Task Force will meet again on November 05, 2018 via video conferencing/ whatsapp. IMD was requested to provide inputs on meteorology forecast on regular basis in this group. The next meeting shall be taken on Monday (November 05, 2018).
