EXTENDED PRODUCER RESPONSIBILITY- AUTHORISATION

[Extended Producer Responsibility Authorisation for Producer of the Electrical & Electronic Equipment]

2. M/s. Bedy Associates, F-255, Flatted Factory Complex, Okhla, New Delhi-110020 is hereby granted Extended Producer Responsibility - Authorisation based on:
 - (a) Extended Producer Responsibility plan and;
 - (b) Proposed target for collection of E-waste submitted by them.

M/s. Bedy Associates, New Delhi shall meet the yearly collection target for e-waste as per the table below:

3. The Authorisation shall be valid for a period of five (5) years from the date of issue with following conditions:
 - i. You shall strictly follow the approved Extended Producer Responsibility Plan, a copy of which is enclosed herewith as Enclosure-I.
 - ii. You shall ensure that collection mechanism or centre or points are set up or designated as per the details given in the Extended Producer Responsibility Plan and that shall be completed before the proposed dates if any in the EPR Plan. (List of Collection Centres/ Points and the toll free numbers for reverse logistics enclosed);

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- iii. You shall ensure that all the collected e-waste is channelized to your authorised recycler 3R recycler, having dismantling facility located at Plot No. 266, sector – 8, IMT Manesar, Gurgaon, Haryana – 122052 and records shall be maintained both at recyclers end as well as at your end.
- iv. You shall maintain records, in Form-2 of these Rules of e-waste and make such records available for scrutiny by Central Pollution Control Board as and when directed;
- v. You shall file annual returns in Form-3 to the Central Pollution Control Board on or before 30th day of June following the financial year to which that returns relates and you shall submit sales data for the FY 2016-17 for Code ITEW7 along with the annual return for FY 2016-17;

vi. General Terms & Conditions of the Authorisation:

- a. The authorisation shall comply with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the E-waste (Management) Rules, 2016 made there under;
- b. The authorisation or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorised by the Central Pollution Control Board;
- c. Any change in the approved Extended Producer Responsibility plan should be informed to Central Pollution Control Board within 15 days on which decision shall be communicated by Central Pollution Control Board within sixty days;
- d. It is the duty of the authorised person to take prior permission of the Central Pollution Control Board to close down any collection centre/points or any other facility which are part of the EPR plan.
- e. An application for the renewal of authorisation shall be made as laid down in sub-rule (vi) of rule of 13(1) the E- Waste (Management) Rules, 2016;
- f. The Central Board reserves right to cancel/amend/revoke the authorisation at any time as per the policy of the Central Board or as notified by the Government from time to time.

vii. Additional Conditions:

- a. Whenever RoHS sampling and testing will be carried out by CPCB, you have to bear the cost of equipment – Copying Equipment (ITEW7) and the cost of testing as per Rule 16 (9) of the E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016;
- b. That the applicant will submit revised application for grant of EPR Authorization, when it will engage any PRO or change its EPR Plan;



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- c. That the applicant has to ensure that e-waste collected at collection centres, through reverse logistic service and through specific collection schemes like buy-back and DRS mentioned in the application should reach to its authorized dismantler/recycler;
- d. That the applicant has to submit to CPCB every quarter the amount of (in number or weight) of e-waste of EEE Code – ITEW7 collected in that quarter and recycled;
- e. That the applicant has to maintain all the technical documentation on RoHS for verification by CPCB/SPCB whenever required;
- f. In case of any violation of the above condition, your authorization will be suspended/cancelled;
