Syllabus for Written Examination for the post of Assistant Law Officer in CPCB-reg

Exam Duration - 3 Hours

Note : A person willing to be Assistant Law Officer in Central Pollution Control Board is expected to know a fair amount of Environmental Law and Jurisprudence, Constitutional Law Principles and procedural law. In view of this the following syllabus is proposed to test the knowledge of candidates for the said post.

1. Basic Understanding of Environmental issues-Meaning of Environment and complexity of environmental governance-
2. Constitutional Dimensions of Environment : Right to Wholesome Environment : Evolution and Application, Relevant Provisions: Art: 14, 19 (1) (g), 21, 48-A, 51-A(g), Public Interest Litigation & Environment Protection
3. Prevention and Control of Water, Air and Noise Pollution : Definition of Water and Air pollution, Central, State and Joint Pollution Control Boards, Sampling procedures, Consent requirements and citizens' suit provisions, Noise Pollution Control Order, 2000.
4. Environmental Protection Act 1986, nature of the Act, meaning of environmental pollution, environmental pollutant, powers and functions of central government, public participation and citizen's suit provisions
5. Law Related to Forests and Wild life: Forest Act 1927, classification of forests, Reserve, Protected, Village and private forests, Forest Conservation Act 1980, Wild Life Protection Act 1972, authorities to be appointed and constituted under the Act, protection strategies, trade or commerce in wild animals, animal article and trophies.
6. National Green Tribunal : Constitution and Powers & functions
7. Basic procedures, Nuisance procedures under Cr.P.C (Section 133) and CPC.
