[Extended Producer Responsibility Authorisation for Producer of the Electrical & Electronic Equipment]

Ref: Your application for Grant of Extended Producer Responsibility - Authorisation for following Electrical & Electronic Equipment under E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016

I. Cellular Telephones: Smart Phones & Feature Phones (ITEW15);

- 2. M/s Eurolink, A-197, Street No. 10, Road No. 4, Mahipalpur, New Delhi- 110037 is hereby granted Extended Producer Responsibility - Authorisation based on:**

- (a) Extended Producer Responsibility plan and;**
- (b) Proposed target for collection of E-waste submitted by them.**

M/s Eurolink shall meet the yearly collection target for e-waste as per the table given below:

- 3. The Authorisation shall be valid for a period of five (5) years from date of issue with following conditions:**

- i. You shall strictly follow the approved Extended Producer Responsibility plan, a copy of which is enclosed herewith as Enclosure-I;**
- ii. You shall ensure that collection mechanism or collection Centres are set up or designated as per the details given in the Extended Producer Responsibility plan and that shall be completed before the proposed dates if any in the EPR Plan (list of collection Centres and the toll free numbers for reverse logistics enclosed);**

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- iii. You shall ensure that all the collected e-waste is channelized to your authorised dismantler/recycler M/s E Waste Recyclers India, E-50, UPSIDC, Industrial Area, 98Km Stone, NH 2, Kosi Kotawan Distt. Mathura, U.P. and records shall be maintained both at recyclers end as well as at your end;
- iv. You shall maintain records, in Form-2 of these Rules, of e-waste and make such records available for scrutiny by Central Pollution Control Board as and when directed;
- v. You shall file annual returns in Form-3 to the Central Pollution Control Board on or before 30th day of June following the financial year to which that returns relates;
- vi. You shall submit annual sales data along with your annual returns.

vii. General Terms & Conditions of the Authorisation:

- a. The authorisation shall comply with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the E-waste (Management) Rules, 2016 made there under;
- b. The authorisation or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorised by the Central Pollution Control Board;
- c. Any change in the approved Extended Producer Responsibility plan should be informed to Central Pollution Control Board within 15 days on which decision shall be communicated by Central Pollution Control Board within sixty days;
- d. It is the duty of the authorised person to take prior permission of the Central Pollution Control Board to close down any collection centre/points or any other facility which are part of the EPR plan.
- e. An application for the renewal of authorisation shall be made as laid down in sub-rule (vi) of rule of 13(1) the E- Waste (Management) Rules, 2016;
- f. The Central Board reserves right to cancel/amend/revoke the authorisation at any time as per the policy of the Central Board or as notified by the Government from time to time.

viii. Additional Conditions: -

- a) That the applicant will submit revised application for grant of EPR Authorisation in case of applicant engaging any PRO or changing its EPR Plan;

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- b) That the applicant has to ensure that the e-waste collected at collection centres and through buy-back and exchange scheme mentioned in the application should reach to its authorized dismantler/recycler;
- c) That the applicant has to modify the agreement with its recyclers and dismantlers by adding a clause that they have capabilities to handle, dismantle and recycle EEE item code ITEW15 (Feature Phones & smart Phones) including its components, consumables, parts and spares and submit to CPCB within three (03) weeks of receiving this EPR Authorization;
- d) That the applicant has to ensure that the address in its IEC certificate should be modified and it should be same as given at point no 1 of the Form – 1 and submit the same to CPCB within three (03) weeks of receiving this EPR Authorisation;
- e) That the applicant has to submit to CPCB every quarter the amount of E-waste (in weight) of EEE code – ITEW15 (Feature Phones & smart Phones) collected in that quarter and recycled;
- f) That the applicant has to submit Enclosure-A of the self-declaration whenever it launches any new model of its product;
- g) That the applicant has to provide RoHS information on the booklet and brochures of their Products;
- h) That the applicant has to ensure that the Bills/Invoices of sale of EEE have to contain information on toll free number, web site link for collection, channelisation of e-waste;
- i) That the applicant has to maintain all the technical documentation on RoHS for verification by CPCB/SPCB whenever required;
- j) In case of any violation of the above condition, your authorization will be suspended/cancelled;
- k) Time lines mentioned above has to be strictly met, failing which authority shall automatically stand withdrawn.
