In this regard, the matter discussed during the meeting on 22.12.2017 at CPCB and displayed one of the petroleum manufacturing industries i.e. M/s ONGC Mangalore Petrochemical Ltd(OMPL), Mangalore, Karnataka. The system was functional and emission limit changes automatically when the fuel changes from liquid to gas and vice versa. The installation/connectivity of 46 flowmeters should not be a reason to implement the dynamic emission in the furnaces/heaters etc.

In view of above you are directed to implement the dynamic limit immediately. Non-compliance of the above direction will lead to levying environmental compensation charges for the period starting from 22.02.2018 till the date of compliance.
