Sub- Direction under section 31 A of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 regarding open dumping/burning of garbage and C & D waste on land owning agencies to control air pollution in Delhi-NCR-reg.

CPCB issued direction under section 31 A of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 on **16.01.2019** regarding non-compliance of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 & Plastic Management Rules, 2016. Accordingly, Environmental Compensation of Rs. One Crore was imposed.

Subsequently, South Delhi Municipal Corporation (SDMC) requested vide letter dated 29.01.2019 to waive off Environmental Compensation.

CPCB officers visited randomly selected areas under jurisdiction of SDMC to verify the claims of SDMC with respect to implementation of SWM & PWM Rules, 2016 in April, 2019. Following were the observation of the inspection:

- 1. The major fraction of the un-segregated municipal solid waste & plastic waste is dumped on open land, dhalaos (Madangiri area etc.) and drains (Okhla Industrial Area etc.).
- Activities like open burning of plastic and garbage (at dhalaos near Modi Mill, Okhla etc.), dumping of garbage, C & D waste (Madangiri area) etc., are still continuing in the area.
- 3. No segregation of MSW at source, open littering, dumping, cattles eating garbage etc., have been reported and thus non-compliance of Solid Waste

Management Rules, 2016 & Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 is observed.

Vide direction no. B-13011/UPCD-II/MSW/2018-19/1247 dated on 16.04.2019, CPCB informed that the application for waving off Environmental Compensation was not accepted and it was directed to deposit the Environmental Compensation with CPCB, as proposed earlier. However, no reply has been received from the SDMC in this matter till date.

In view of above, it is directed to deposit earlier proposed Environmental Compensation of Rs. One Crore with 12% interest from 17.04.2019 till date immediately with CPCB.
