It is to inform you that M/s Shree Balaji Processors, Opposite Central Jail, Tajpur Road, Sir. Ludhiana, Punjab was inspected by a team of CPCB officials on 24.06.2021 to verify the compliance status of the industries under the special drive in catchment of River Sutlej within the jurisdiction of Punjab. The unit was found self-closed reportedly due to Covid-19 pandemic condition. Based on the observations made by the inspection team, the following recommendations are required to be complied by the unit:

- 1. The unit should obtain valid consent under the Water Act, 1974, the Air Act, 1981 and Authorization under the Hazardous Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 from PPCB before start of manufacturing operations.
- 2. The unit shall install differential pressure gauge device at filter system for monitoring the filtration/circulation,
- 3. The unit should upgrade and properly operate its chemical dosing system, Aeration and clarifier units of existing ETP to ensure discharge of waste water within prescribed standards.

In this context, it is requested to ensure implementation of recommendations made in the inspection report before allowing operation and issuance of consent order to the unit.

This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.
