Subject: Guidelines for installation of Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System (OCEMS) in Grossly Polluting Industries-reg.

## Reference:

- 1. CPCB guidelines for OCEMS installation dated 07.11.2014 and July,2018
- 2. CPCB office order dated 27.12.2016

Sir,
This has reference to CPCB directions dated 11.03.2021 issued under section 18 (1)
(b) of the water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, guidelines dated 07.11.2014 and July, 2018 for installation & connectivity of online continuous effluent monitoring systems (OCEMS) by Grossly Polluting Industries (GPIs).

CPCB vide order dated 27.12.2016 issued guidelines for installation of flow meters and web cameras, instead of OCEMS, in GPIs located in seven States & UTs of Ganga and Yamuna having effluent discharge less than 10 KLD or having intermittent discharge. Based on the representations received, CPCB constituted a Committee to review requirements of installations of OCEMS in MSME GPIs, and following shall be implemented in partial modification to above referred guidelines and order:

- The GPIs having potential of wastewater discharge ≤02 KLD and connected to CETPs shall install only flow meter.
- 2. Standalone GPIs having potential of wastewater discharge ≤02 KLD shall install flow meter as well as web camera.

GPIs shall ensure the compliance of the prescribed effluent discharge norms.

SPCBs/PCCs shall take appropriate action to ensure installation & connectivity of OCEMS by-GPIs as per the above mentioned guidelines.
